SKILL DESIGNERS
NIMISHA VERMA, PATNA

Since 2010, Nimisha Verma, founder of SKILL Designers in Patna, has followed a “less is more” philosophy. She has used Fenesta fenestrations in many projects, most notably in a residence near Mangalore at the foothills of the Western Ghats, where they help bring her design vision to life. “Fenesta was the best design element in this project – it brought the vision to life and helped me achieve exactly what I had imagined,” she says. The fenestrations blend seamlessly into the architecture, creating a striking visual impact while allowing nature to flow into the interiors. She particularly values Fenesta’s full-height glass windows, which transform walls into expansive glazing, filling spaces with light and fostering a strong connection to the outdoors.

Designing Earth by Studio Bhoomi, founded by Shelja Gupta in 1999, creates architecture that is deeply connected to land, light, and human experience. In Casa Azul, this philosophy is articulated through fenestration, where openings shape the home’s narrative as meaningfully as its walls. Fenesta windows and doors are treated not as visual statements but as quiet architectural devices, precisely placed to choreograph light, air, and views through the day. “Fenesta fenestrations blend in so naturally that they almost disappear – and that is their greatest strength,” says Shelja. Clean profiles, refined finishes, and elegant detailing preserve visual calm and continuity, while Fenesta’s performance-led systems support climate responsiveness, acoustic comfort, and durability – allowing the windows to quietly complete the architecture rather than interrupt it.

Founded in 1988 by Ridham Seth and Raman Seth, Ideal Home Designers has evolved around a steadfast philosophy they call the “Architecture of Silence,” where calm is created through precise control of light, shadow, proportion, and detail. In a recent residence in Amritsar, challenged by urban noise and thermal gain, the studio turned to Fenesta’s Aluminium Series to help shape a quieter, more comfortable domestic environment. As the designers put it, “When you close a Fenesta door, the city simply ‘turns off,’” a transition they see as central to transforming a house into a true sanctuary. Viewed not as add-ons but as the building’s membrane, Fenesta fenestrations support their minimalist language through crisp junctions between wall and glass, advanced acoustic performance, and innovations like the invisible threshold—allowing interiors to feel seamless, silent, and expansive even within a dense urban context.

Bipratip Dhar’s multidisciplinary practice Epsilon in Kolkata works across architectural and interior projects, from commercial and institutional buildings to finely detailed interiors. The studio’s philosophy draws from multiple architectural eras, combining design clarity, technical precision, and contextual sensitivity. Fenesta fenestrations feature across Epsilon’s projects, where performance and durability are essential to realising design intent. As Bipratip notes, “Fenesta’s windows complement our emphasis on precision, performance, and finish, delivering solutions that are contextually appropriate while meeting contemporary functional and environmental expectations.” This is further reinforced by Fenesta’s system-based approach, aligning with the studio’s belief in architecture as an integrated whole, where every element works in harmony to achieve clarity, durability, and performance.

Bathinda’s Studio Vector, which was founded by Jayant Grover, views design as a personal yet universally comforting expression, shaping spaces that foster individuality and belonging. Fenesta fenestrations have featured across several of their projects, including a music-centric residence where acoustic comfort was essential. Fenesta uPVC windows helped create calm, noise-free interiors while opening up uninterrupted views of the garden. As Jayant notes, “Fenestrations are meant to subtly blend into the façade at times, while at other moments, they are intended to become a highlighted architectural feature.” Valued for its ability to adapt to complex design challenges, from tall openings and open-to-sky spaces to customised arches, Fenesta supports both performance and creative freedom through thoughtful detailing and reliable engineering.
