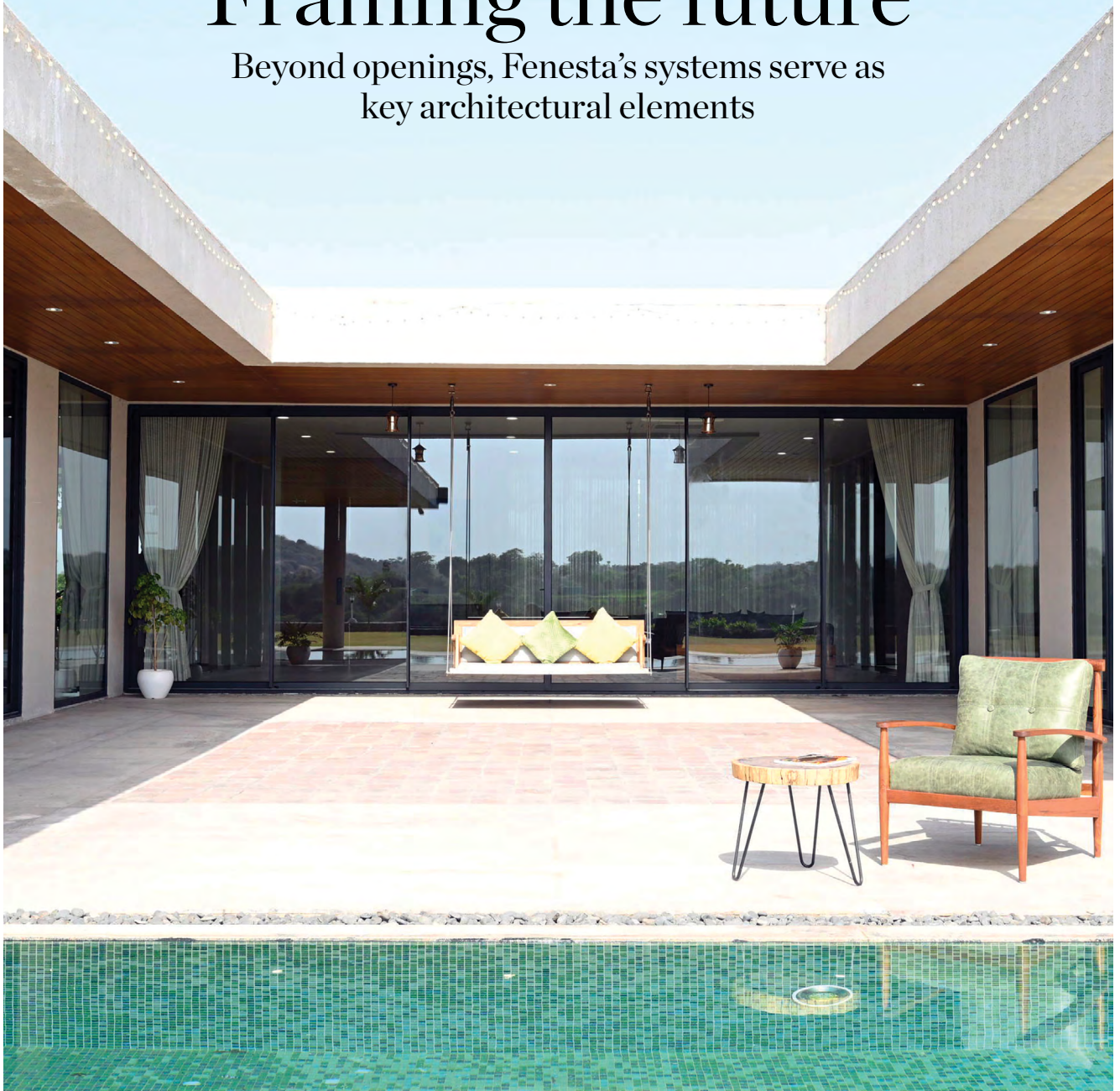

Since 2011, Kiran Hanumaiah's Design Matters Architects has taken a personalised approach to residential architecture, creating homes that are comfortable, functional, and filled with natural light.
